Being Creative

A) Create a city / civilization / country

- This may be done in Lego, Minecraft, cardboard or even a drawing.
- Send a picture, video or attachment of your creation to pingram@gnspes.ca
 - Be sure to include your name.
- Then explain how your creation applies or considers the UN Global Goals.
 - Use the tables provided in the Project Sheet found in Google Classroom!
- How many UN Global Goals should I consider?
 That is up to you. Aim for 400+ words in total.
 Is that 4 Global Goals or 7? You get to decide.

B) Write a story

- This may be a journal of a refugee family, a story of a person growing up in a
 poor country or an inspirational story of a young person changing the world or
 anything else that you want.
- **Send** your story to pingram@qnspes.ca (Be sure to include your name.)
- Then explain how your story applies or considers the UN Global Goals.
 - Use the tables provided in the Project Sheet found in Google Classroom!
- How many UN Global Goals should I consider?
 That is up to you. Aim for 400+ words in total.

C) Create (Draw) a set of pictures.

You should aim to write 400+ words in **total**. You may write 400+ words about one goal or you may write about several goals. Examples:

4 Goals at 100 words each = 400 words 8 Goals at 80 words each = 400 words Choose the appropriate section

If your city helps poor people use Sec # 1 (**Poverty**)
If your city has cool buildings use Sec # 9 (**Infrastructure**)

If your story has hunger in it use sec # 2 (Hunger)

If your picture is about sickness or health use sec # 3 (Health)


