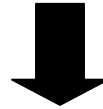


Immigration Project

Section 1) Create a character

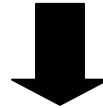
- Tell the characters name and 5 interesting things about the person in point form

Choose any topic from the 'section list' to start the story.

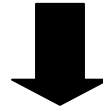
- Make sure you have a title to this section that clearly explains your topic.

Choose any topic from the 'section list' to continue the story.

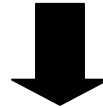
- Make sure you have a title to this section that clearly explains your topic.
